Visiting the Church

The Church remains closed during Mass times and is private for funerals. Otherwise, it is open from 10:30 am to 3:00 pm from Mon. to Sat. for individual visits and personal prayer. You may enter by the side door near the Sacristy. Please use the hand sanitiser, wear a face covering, and observe social distancing.

Some boxes of Collection Envelopes remain to be picked up from the front seats in the Church. The letter box on the inner door of the Sacristy may be used to return collection envelopes and to arrange Masses for anniversaries and other intentions.

We continue to celebrate Mass at the usual times but without a congregation. All Masses are streamed live.

Funeral Masses are streamed live because of limits on attendance in person. If a member of the bereaved family cannot view a Mass at the time of broadcast, we may be able to obtain a recording for later viewing provided we have advance notice of about 24 hours.

Ash Wednesday & the Season of Lent

On Wednesday next, 17th February 2021, we begin the Season of Lent with our observance of Ash Wednesday. Traditionally marked by prayer and fasting, Lent is essentially a time of preparation for Easter and reflection upon the Resurrection.

Lenten Packs: A number of Lenten Packs have been prepared and they will be available for collection in the Church on Ash Wednesday. Each pack contains a Lenten prayer, a Trócaire box and an envelope with dry ashes. Please take one, if you can. Collect one for a friend who may not be able to get out.

The Lenten Prayer is as follows:

*Lord, let Your Spirit guide us in your commandments
Let your Spirit open our voices to proclaim your love
Let your Spirit fill us with energy and life
Let your Spirit come to us in mercy and forgiveness
Amen.*

The Wearing of Ashes: Having ashes blessed and applied to one's forehead is a long-standing tradition as a sign of our creation from dust and a symbol of penance. This year, as we cannot have the usual distribution of ashes with Mass in the Church, you may use the ashes from your Lenten Pack for each other at home or indeed for yourself. You may say these words when applying ashes to the forehead:

Repent and be faithful to the Gospel.

Stations of the Cross on Fridays: Starting on Friday next, 19th Feb. 2021, and for each Friday during Lent, Br. James will lead a Way of the Cross after the 10:00 am Mass. This will be streamed live from the Ambo.

Covid-19 & Vaccination

See the HSE website at www.hse.ie for the latest information on the rollout of coronavirus vaccines. Persons who are most at risk will be offered vaccination first. It is made available free of charge.

Vaccine rollout has begun with healthcare workers and for residents of long-term care facilities. The next cohort, people aged 85 years and over, will be offered vaccination from next week. You can expect to be contacted by your doctor. Other age groups will be invited in turn.

You may discuss your situation with a healthcare professional if you have any allergies, if you've previously had allergic reaction to vaccine, if you have Covid or Covid symptoms or fever.
