Laetare Sunday

The Entrance Antiphon begins today with the words: Rejoice, Jerusalem, in Latin: Laetare, Jerusalem. It marks a time of celebration as we are past the half-way point in Lent and looking forward to the Resurrection.

Bishop St. Oscar Romero

On Friday, 24th March 2023, we remember Oscar Romero, Archbishop of San Salvador, who was shot dead on 24th March 1980 while celebrating Mass. An outspoken critic of violence from all sides of the conflict in El Salvador, he was an advocate for social justice. In 2015, Bishop Romero was declared a martyr and beatified. In 2018, he was canonised.
