## Returning to Church

So far, the return of parishioners to Mass is working well. You are being careful to observe the public health guidelines and the attendance is safely managed in separate pods.

- Seating positions are marked and cordoned off. Ushers will help you to find an empty seat at weekend Masses.
- At Communion time, people in different seating blocks come forward separately so as to avoid meeting in the aisles.
- When approaching the Altar and returning to your seat, please hold back 2 metres from the person in front of you.
- Individual Baptisms may be booked for Saturday at 5:00 pm or Sunday at 12:15 pm. Please contact the Parish Clerk or one of the priests.

# **Eucharistic Ministry**

For the time being, with reduced numbers attending Mass, we have just two distribution points for Holy Communion and we do not need to operate a rota of Eucharistic Ministers.

Until a higher level of vaccination has been achieved, we are not in a position to resume the weekly service of bringing Holy Communion to the housebound. We hope that the situation will be better in the Autumn. In the meantime, Fr. Mc Auliffe has resumed his First Friday visits to the housebound.

## Preparing for the Sacraments

## Public Health Advice

Although the vaccination programme is proceeding at pace, we are advised by the HSE to continue to observe the usual precautions. Remember the vaccine protects you against Covid-19 illness but it may not prevent you picking up the virus and passing it on to someone more vulnerable.

- Wash your hands frequently. Use the hand sanitiser as you enter Church and as you leave.
- Cover any coughs or sneezes with a tissue or your sleeve. Bin used tissues and wash your hands.
- At home, open doors and windows as much as possible to let fresh air circulate.
- Wear a face mask, to cover your nose and mouth, both inside and around the Church.
- Your mask is worn to protect those around you and they wear masks to protect you.
- Keep 2 metres from others at all times. Avoid crowds. Do not congregate around the Church.
