THE CRIB: In 1223 when most ordinary people could not read, St. Francis decided he would demonstrate the Christmas story in a way everyone could understand. He set up a stable scene in a cave not far from his home in Assisi, 🐹 with real people and animals. As people gathered around to 🕅 see what he was doing, he told them how Jesus had been 🤅 born in a simple stable and how angels had appeared to shepherds telling them to go and find for themselves the Messiah who had been born. Now 800 years on from the first 🔭 Christmas crib scene in history the tradition is passed on in 💦 homes and communities across the world bringing with it a 🔇 message of hope and peace which never fades away.
