It is planned to produce an information leaflet for distribution to all houses in our parish containing details as to the many organisations within our parish. The Parish website is to be updated to eliminate the current problems.

The Parish Council is to give a Guardian Angel Card to each child to commemorate their First Holy Communion. This is to be distributed to them on the night of their First Confession. The Easter Dues envelopes are to be distributed over the next week. There was further discussion on the plans for the 60th Anniversary Celebrations of our Parish to be held in October next. The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday 9th April.
