SEEING YOUR LIFE THROUGH THE LENS OF THE GOSPELS

Mark 9:2-10

- 1. Some special spiritual experiences are well-nigh impossible to describe in words. The Transfiguration was one of these. Jesus had a new and deeper insight into his relationship with his heavenly Father, one that would sustain him though what lay ahead of him. Have you had WOW moments that you found hard to describe to others? How have these sustained you in difficult times.
- 2. It can be both scary and wonderful to witness transformation in another, especially a person who is close. At times parents get a taste of this when a child's talent blossoms and is recognised by the child. We may also experience it when a dear friend recognises s/he is in a blind alley and gives up an addiction.
- 3. 'This is my Son, whom I love. Listen to him.' Peter, James and John were particularly close to Jesus but they were not good at listening to Jesus, especially when he spoke of the painful load of servant discipleship. Jesus is the one we must listen to, even when this message is hard to hear, for it is in this message we find life. When have you found this to be true.
- 4. Strangely, this instruction came to the disciples when they were confused and 'in a cloud'. Perhaps you recall a moment of insight coming to you at a time when you were confused.

PARISH ENVELOPE SYSTEM: Fr McAuliffe, Fr Ryan and the Parish Finance Committee would like to thank you all most sincerely for your contributions towards the upkeep of the Church and the parish.

To explain the Envelope System: under current tax legislation the parish receives a tax rebate on donations of €250 or more in a tax year. Such contributions made by parishioners may consist of the weekly envelope collections and also the Christmas and Easter dues. This rebate amounts to approximately €112 for every €250 donated to the parish annually.In 2015 the tax refunds to the parish totalled approximately €30,000.

Parishioners who are in the Envelope System are each given a number and a record is kept of their weekly donations. If their entire contribution during the year including their Easter and Christmas dues amount to more than €250, the parish receives a rebate.

However there are parishioners whose total Christmas and Easter dues are €250 or more but who are not in the Envelope System – the parish can claim for rebate on their dues contribution but not on their weekly contributions to the plate, because it is not recorded (under the Envelope System).

Also, there are parishioners who are not in the Envelope System and whose dues contributions are less than €250 per annum but when taken together with their weekly plate contributions would amount to €250 or more – the parish cannot claim for a rebate in respect of any of these contributions.

The parish would benefit greatly from the additional rebate it would receive from the latter two categories. Therefore the Parish Finance Committee would be very grateful if you would please consider signing up to the Envelope System. You can do this by calling to Margaret in the office.

Signing up to the Envelope System does not commit parishioners to a weekly contribution and you are free to opt out at any time.

Eligible contributors complete a simple tax form every 5 years. The Parish will contact the relevant people regarding this as needed.
