#### **Anne Thurston - Small Wonders**

The word Lent comes from the Old English word meaning Spring. In this hemisphere, the cycles of ritual memory and of nature meet. As we enter the forty days of desert, nature is insisting vehemently on life's return. As we learn, through liturgical patterns, that unless a seed falls to the ground and dies it cannot live, nature illustrates the process.

Lenten days, Spring days, are full of promise. The Earth renews itself and the prayer of the psalmist is echoed:

Create in me a clean heart, O God

And put a new and right spirit within me [Psalm 51:10]
