Report on Meeting with Bishop Leahy

On Wednesday last, 15th November 2023, Bishop Brendan Leahy met with parishioners from Pastoral Units 4, 5 and 6. Our Lady of the Rosary Parish is in Pastoral Unit 5 with Christ the King and Cratloe / Sixmilebridge. Bishop Leahy began the meeting with a short video on the recent Synod in Rome, where he was one of two Irish delegates. He said it was a very good synod where delegates sat in groups of 11 around circular tables. The groups consisted of priests, religious and lay people, both men and women.

Bishop Leahy outlined the present situation in the Diocese of Limerick, which is presented in the 'Overview 2023' booklet and he asked where our diocese would be in 15 year's time. He said we must act while we have the energy to think outside the box of our own parish. He thanked all those who volunteer in our parishes. Time was given for group discussion on the way forward for our parishes at the end of which many viewpoints and suggestions were made to all in attendance and recorded. It is the First Step in the process – a conversation and listening step.
