ADVENT: The word 'Advent' is from the Latin 'Adventus,' which means 'coming'. The Church teaches us that during Advent we wait for two comings of Christ: we prepare to celebrate Christmas when Christ first came into the world and we wait for Christ's second coming at the end of time. Advent is the beginning of a new liturgical year, it begins at sundown on the eve of the fourth Sunday before Christmas and ends at sundown on Christmas Eve. The liturgical colour for this season is purple.

ADORATION: Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament returns on the First Friday of each month beginning on Friday, 2 December after the 10 am Morning Mass. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will be for one hour after Mass. Parishioners are invited to spend some time in prayer/reflection during this time. If you are free to devote an hour of your time to help with the organisation and be in

attendance in the church for the duration, please give your name and contact number to Margaret in the sacristy. Note: If there is a funeral in the parish on that day there will be no adoration.
