PALM SUNDAY

We wish all our Parishioners a very Happy Easter and invite you to the Holy Week/Easter Ceremonies in Our Lady of the Rosary Church

PALM SUNDAY:

This weekend we celebrate Palm Sunday – it is the first day of Holy Week. There are two parts to our celebration. The first is the blessing of the Palm. It reminds us of the way in which the people of Jerusalem acclaimed Jesus when He came into their city on the first Palm Sunday. We are invited to take a sprig of Palm before the ceremony begins. It is blessed and we are encouraged to take it home, to bring protection to our homes. The second part of the celebration is the reading of the account of the Passion of Jesus according to St. Matthew. This account begins with the betrayal of Jesus by Judas. This is almost like a bridge between the acclamation of Palm Sunday and the events of Holy Week. It highlights the ease with which we can change our minds and our allegiance to our conscience and to our God. We can be full of praise and acceptance of others at any moment and we can very quickly change our minds and become their judges.
