Celebrating 60 Years of Parish

We will mark the occasion of the **60th Anniversary of Our Parish**, in the week running up to the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, 7 October 2024. Our original Church was built in 1950 as a Chapel of Ease in St. Munchin's Parish and it was only at the end of 1964 that Our Lady of the Rosary was established as a Parish in its own right.

A **Special Mass of Celebration** will be held on Sunday 6 October at 11:30 am. It will be followed by refreshments in the Parish Centre. All parishioners are invited to attend.

From Saturday 28 September to Sunday 6 October we are planning a **Novena of Celebration** with a week of reflection on how blessed we are as members of the parish of Our Lady of the Rosary. At the 10:00 am Weekday Masses, we will reflect on sources of that blessing and thank God for His goodness to us.

- On Thursday 3 Oct Feast of Blessed Columba Marmion - we celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation after Mass.
- On Friday 4 Oct Feast of St Francis of Assisi we celebrate the Sacrament of the Sick. All are invited to receive the Sacrament.

At the 6:00 pm Vigil Mass on Saturday, we thank God for the Sacrament of Marriage and for all families in our parish.

On Sunday 6 Oct, a day of special celebration for the **Foundation of our Parish**, we celebrate the usual 10:00 am Mass and the Special Mass at 11:30 am.
