THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY PARISH PILGRIM WALK: The late Pope Francis designated the 2025 Holy Year as a time to renew ourselves as "Pilgrims of Hope." Last Saturday 24 May after 6pm Mass parishioners met in pilgrimage at the ruins of Kilrush church, the oldest church in Limerick City. Canon Donagh O'Malley gave a very interesting talk on Kilrush Church after 6pm Mass. He described the history of it saying that the church was first mentioned in 1201 but the huge building blocks and lintel stone suggests its earlier and pre-Norman/Romanesque origins. He explained that the area had also been used as a Killeen and a burial ground. He described the link between the building of the church at the time of St Munchin back to St. Patrick. According to one tradition, little Kilrush is said to have been built by Rose, a sister of St. Munchin. More than 50 parishioners walked or drove to Kilrush Church where there was a short service ending with a rendition of Hail Glorious St Patrick. Canon Donagh asked us to remember all those who had been buried there and all those who had handed down the faith through the generations.
