Limerick Holy Year Exhibition 1950

An exhibition titled 'A Thousand Years of Christian Art and Ecclesiastical Antiquities from North Munster' was held in St. Munchin's New Church Building (Our Lady of the Rosary Church) from November 26 to December 3, 1950. This was under the patronage of Most Rev. Patrick O'Neill, Lord Bishop of Limerick, and it included the Ardagh Chalice and the O'Keeffe Chalice.

Blessing of Our Lady of The Rosary Church

"On Monday 11 December 1950 at 12:30 Most Reverend Dr. O'Neill imparted the Ritual Blessing to the new church of Our Lady of the Rosary. The Bishop was assisted by Rev. Monsignor Moloney P.P. St Munchin's, Very Rev. Canon Lee P.P. St Mary's, Very Rev. Dr. Cowper P.P. St Patricks, Very Rev. Wm O'Grady, Adm. St. John's. Vested in alb, stole and cope, the Bishop made an external circuit of the church sprinkling it with holy water.

As his Lordship entered the church for the internal Blessing the Assembled clergy sang the Litany of the Saints. The blessing of the altar and walls having been completed, the bishop canonically erected the stations of the cross, the Te Deum being chanted by the Clergy."
